Provisional Associate Membership

The Society of Experimental Test Pilots (SETP) constitution provides a Provisional Associate Member category for pilots graduating from SETP recognized schools. This provisional category provides for a 3 year membership which will allow you to gain the experience requirements needed for a full Associate Member or Member status. Within that time we are certain that you will meet the qualification criteria.

SETP recognized schools: graduates of the Empire Test Pilot School, the U.S. Navy Test Pilot School, the U.S. Air Force Test Pilot School, the French Test Pilot School (EPNER), the National Test Pilot School (11 month course), the Indian Air Force Test Pilot School, or the Brazilian Test Pilot School (EFEV – Esquadrao de Formacao em Ensaios em Voo)

Graduates of the above schools may be granted provisional ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP based solely on graduation for a period of up to three years from the date of graduation, after which the applicant must document qualifying experience in accordance with standard membership requirements in order to continue as a member of the Society.
