NASA's First All-Female Spacewalk Makes History - International Space Station

US astronauts Christina Koch and Jessica Meir became the first all-female pairing to carry out a spacewalk today, a historic milestone as NASA prepares to send the first woman to the Moon. Koch, an electrical engineer who is leading the mission, is carrying out her fourth spacewalk and was hooked up to the station's robot arm. Meir, who holds a doctorate in marine biology and is making her first ever spacewalk, made her way carefully across using handles. The two were working to replace a faulty battery charge/discharge unit, known as a BCDU. The station relies on solar power but is out of direct sunlight for much of its orbit and therefore needs batteries, and the BCDUs regulate the amount of charge that goes into them. New York Times



SyberJet Successfully Completes First Flight of SJ30i Series Aircraft - San Antonio, TX SyberJet Aircraft has successfully completed the first flight of its SJ30i aircraft featuring SyberVisionTM, an all-new cockpit based around the Honeywell Epic 2.0 avionics suite, new ergonomic enhancements, electronic standby attitude/heading display, and much more. SyberJet conducted the flight on 11

October out of its Engineering and Product Development Center at the San Antonio International Airport (KSAT) and kicked off an 18-month certification test program which will culminate in an amended type certificate for the SJ30i and immediate subsequent deliveries thereafter. Mark Elwess (M), Chief Engineering Test Pilot and Senior Flight Test Engineer Robert Moehle put the aircraft through its paces during the flight. The SJ30i, with SyberVisionTM, retains all of the same performance characteristics of SyberJet's current SJ30-2 model but features four 12-inch liquid crystal displays, including the SmartView™ synthetic vision system (SVS), INAV™ moving map display system, electronics charts/maps, TCAS II, TAWS Level A, synoptic displays, dual flight management systems (FMS) with dual WAAS GPS/LPV, single inertial navigation system (IRS), onboard weather radar, full EICAS, electronic checklists, DME, ADS-B Out, and 0.3 nm RNP, as well as support for FANS-1A, SmartLanding™, SmartRunway™, TOLD, ADS-B In, emergency descent mode, and RVSM operations. Options include CPDLC, XM weather, flight data recorder, cockpit voice recorder, dual charts/maps, HF radio, SATCOM, enhanced vision systems, second MFD, and the flexibility for other customer requests. XQ-58A Valkyrie Drone Suffers Damage After Third Flight Test – Yuma, AZ

The Kratos XQ-58A Valkyrie unmanned aircraft sustained some amount of damage in a recent mishap on Oct. 9, 2019, after the XQ-58A had landed. High surface winds and a malfunction of the vehicle's provisional flight test recovery system resulted in a mishap. The prototype cushion system, which was employed for the initial test series but is not intended for ultimate operational use, suffered an anomaly resulting in the aircraft sustaining damage upon touchdown. Though past Air Force concept art of a notional low-cost attritable aircraft showed a tricycle landing gear configuration, Kratos has been recovering the XQ-58A after test flights using a traditional parachute recovery system. This means that after the drone finishes its flight, its engine shuts off and it deploys a parachute. Airbags also deploy and cushion the unmanned aircraft when it hits the ground. This is a proven concept that has been in use on drones since the 1970s and it's unclear how the malfunction occurred in this particular incident. The Drive
