MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Happy New Year! We had a banner year in symposia attendance in 2008. Last vear there were nine total symposia, including three new one-day symposia in Ohio; Wichita, Dayton, and Ft Walton Kansas: Beach, Florida. All three of the new venues were successful and are planning events again this year as well. We also had a large turnout for the annual Symposium and Awards Banduet in Anaheim. California - 720 registered at that symposium. Because of the large number of smaller symposia and the big in attendance Anaheim. more papers were seen and the lessons learned were heard by many more of our members than ever before. But even with all of that success, only about 30% of our 2.300 members worldwide got the opportunity to attend a symposium in The person last year. technical proceedings and lessons learned are broadly distributed however: you have should already received a copy of the 2008 Symposium Proceedings in the mail, and archival papers are available online through

the "members-only" section of our web site. But I think we can do better. initiative I and your Board of Directors are exploring is to potentially do an audio and video capture of each technical paper or panel discussion and make them available for download over the internet through the password-protected section of our web site. We'll need some audio-visual expertise hardware specialized accomplish this and our first attempt to do it will be at the San Diego Symposium in March. If that works well then we'll do it again in Anaheim in September. If it works as envisioned, I think we'll dramatically increase value to our world-wide membership. If you have any ideas concerning this initiative I invite you to share them with me or any member of the Board of Directors.

EASA Concerning the proposed rules concerning flight test crew qualifications mentioned in the last newsletter, the Board of Directors voted on 22 January to approve a set of SETP comments. comments were detailed, but the focus of the comments centered on three main themes. First, we suggested that there should be an alternative path to qualification beyond formal test pilot training. Secondly we proposed that there should be a lesser level of formal training required for small, simple aircraft. And third it was suggested that all seven SETP recognized test pilot schools be accepted as providing acceptable training. Many thanks to all who contributed ideas including Jeremy Grady Wilson, Tracey, Bernhard Beazley, Berset, Roger

Didier Poisson, and Arun Karwal. But the biggest share of the load was carried by our Legal Officer, Doug Benjamin. Thanks, Doug.

The purpose of the Safety Workshop is to provide an open forum where test safety issues can be presented, discussed and probed with other members and disciplines of the flight test community. Maurice J. Girard, Senior Test Pilot, Cessna Aircraft Company, Rob Erdos, Chief Test Pilot, National Research Council of Canada, the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, the Society of Experimental Test Pilots and the Society of Flight Test Engineers are coordinating the event.

The theme of the workshop is "The Human-Machine Interface and its Relationship to Understanding and Managing Human Error".
